



Radiating felt flower



Ø ± 20 cm

Needed:

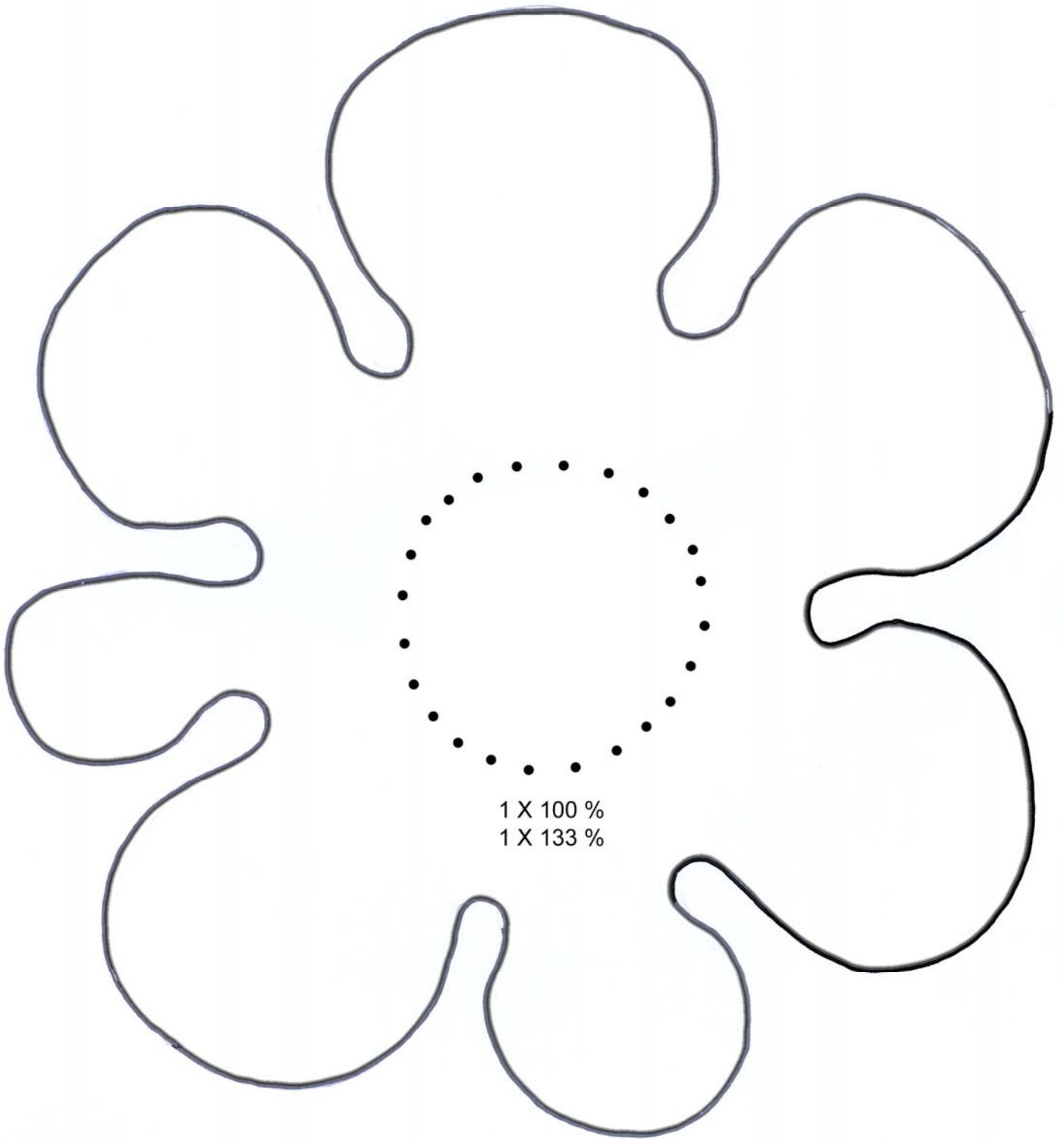
- Woollen felt sun yellow 20 x 22 cm (V503)
- Woollen felt orange 20 x 22 cm (V504)
- Woollen felt red 30 x 30 cm (V507)
- Woollen felt burgundy red 30 x 30 cm (V523)
- Light cord with 10 lights
- Tierip

!	Please read the entire instructions before beginning !
First:	The enclosed pattern is for the smaller inner flower. Enlarge this pattern by 33% for the outer flower.
1.	Place the piece of yellow and orange felt together and pin on the pattern of the smaller flower. Using a sewing machine, sew along the pattern using a very small straight stitch. Repeat for the larger flower using the dark red and red felt.
2.	Cut out the flowers leaving a very small seam allowance. Pull the centre of the two layers of felt slightly apart and cut a cross in the orange, respectively dark red felt.
3.	Push the scissors between the two layers and cut out from (only) the <u>yellow, respectively red</u> felt a circle of around 5 cm.
4.	Reverse the flowers through this circle using the back side of a wooden spoon. Using the stem of the spoon, move along the inside of the flower seams to 'blow' it up.
5.	Take all of the lights and use the tierip to bind them tightly together just under the bulbs.
6.	Using a double thread, baste along the edge of the cut out circle in the middle of the yellow/orange flower, using +/- 0.5 cm long stitches. Leave the thread hanging.
7.	Push the plug starting from the yellow side through the inner flower (enlarge the cut if necessary, although the felt stretches a lot). Push the flower up just under the lights, pull firmly on the thread and knot.
8.	Repeat the process with the red flower. Push the red flower as close as possible against the yellow flower. Pull on the gathering thread, knot (*) and stitch to the back. Gather the opening at the back side around the cords and knot (*)
9.	Pull the thread through the middle of the bundle of lights and stitch again to the back. In this way, the flower will not shift away from the lights. Knot firmly.
	* use the same thread as long as possible, even after knotting.
	<p>What can you do with these pretty flowers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - hang them up somewhere nice, as original light decoration. - Make an unusual table lamp: take three flowers, bind them together and place them on a covered cardboard cone (**), which has an opening in the bottom for the cord. - Take sticks or branches and attach the flowers to the top side. Attach the flower at the end with a tie rope. You can make leaves using folded felt with a piece of electricity wire as vein in the middle (sew along the right and left side of the vein). In this way, you can bend the leaf to your desires. Sew the horizontal veins first ! <p>(**) Ask for a piece of cardboard carpet roll at a carpet dealer.</p>

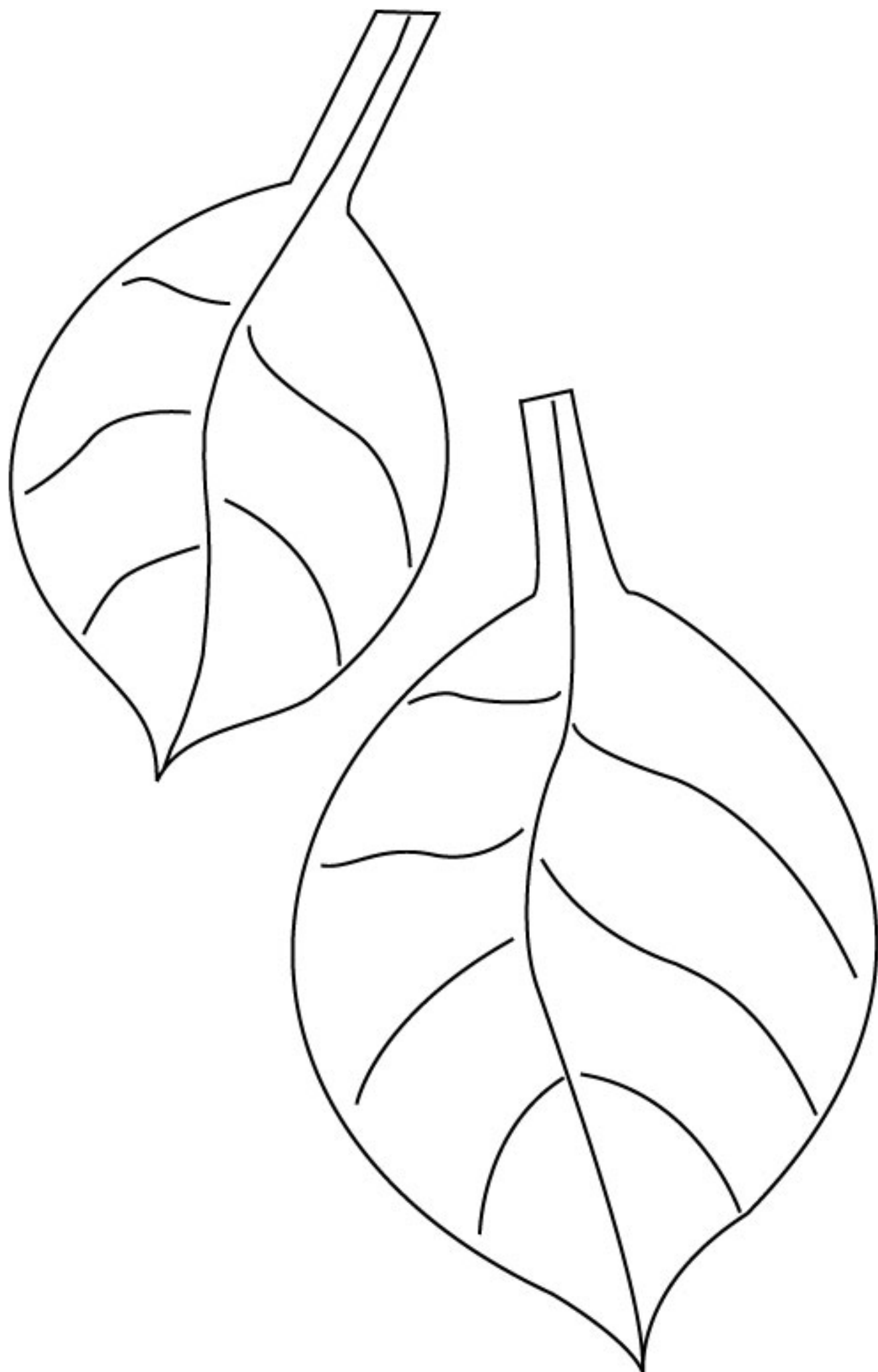
